## **REGISTRATION PROCEDURES**

### **Entry Fees:**

All teams entering the NWT Curling Championships must complete the attached Team Registration Form in full. Team members must also sign and date the attached Player Affidavit Form. The entry fees will be paid prior to the start of the Championship involved. Entry fees for the 2005 – 2006 season are: \$300 per team for all adult teams per category and \$100.00 for Juniors. All cheques are to be made payable to the NWT Curling Association.

**Incomplete forms and late entries will not be accepted.**

### **Competitor Fees:**

All individuals wishing to enter the NWT Curling Championships must also pay a competitor fee of \$25.00 per adult. (Juniors excluded). Upon receipt of the Registration Form, the Treasurer will invoice the competitor's home club for competitor fees.

**Note: All competitors should be aware of the following with respect to the Northwest Territories/Yukon Curling Championships and how it may affect them:**

**In the event that a hosting association has only one team and the visiting association has two teams in an individual championship, the visiting association has the choice of hosting the event subject to the following:**

- a) **The new host association pays the travel cost of the visiting team, such cost to be limited to 4 team members and the lowest available airfare between the lesser of:
  - i) the original host site and the new host site,
  - ii) the original association's territorial capital city and the new host site; and
  - iii) the competing team's home community and the new host site.**
- b) **The visiting association must declare their wish to host the championship within 24 hours of the original host notifying them that they have only one team.**

**\*If both associations only have one team, the host site remains as scheduled.**

**In the event that a non-hosting association has only one team in an individual championship, the hosting association has the option of providing three teams to compete in that championship.**

**Athletes competing at the Northwest Territories/Yukon Curling Championship level will be responsible for booking flights and paying for their airfare prior to departure. The NWT Curling Association pays \$2000.00/team towards this travel when the championship is in the Yukon or ½ of the actual travel expenses (up to \$2,000 booked at the lowest fare possible) when it is in the NWT. This applies only to the top two qualifying teams; in the case where a third NWT team competes in a NWT/Yukon Championship, they will receive no funding from the NWT Curling Association.**

### **Eligibility:**

All competitors must be affiliated members of the Northwest Territories Curling Association for the championship season in which that championship is being played.

**Age Requirements:**

All competitors must meet the age requirements as per the Canadian Curling Association Rules of Play in effect for the year in which the championship is being played.

**Length of Competitions:**

The start date of competitions will depend on the number of teams entered and the number of sheets of ice available at the host club. All teams should be prepared to begin play during the middle of the week. All competitions play to completion at the host club and end on Sunday, unless extenuating circumstances apply.

**Accommodation, Transportation and Meals:**

Individuals are responsible for arranging their own accommodation, transportation and meals for any championship. A Banquet will be provided at each Championship which is included in the Entry Fee.

**Confirmation:**

Teams will be provided with confirmation of their registration by return fax or email.

Teams will be provided a copy of the schedule and draw for their competition on the Wednesday following the registration deadline of their respective championship events.

## **OBLIGATIONS AND SANCTIONS**

### **Obligations of Competitors/Coaches:**

1. All competitors entering an NWT Championship shall abide by the Rules of Officiated Play of the Canadian Curling Association and the NWTCA Championship Rules and Policies. The spirit of fair play and sportsmanship should be exhibited. Reminder: Only **two** player changes may be made to the team from the start of club play downs through to the national level of play.
2. Teams entering NWT Championships must be prepared to continue to the next level of play should they be declared NWT Champions at the end of the Championships involved. Should any changes be made to the initial team roster on the registration form, they must be immediately submitted to the Championship Director as well.
3. At least one member of the team must be in attendance at the Team Meeting.
4. All members of the team must be in attendance at the Banquet and Opening Ceremonies of the Championship involved.
5. Over consumption of alcohol or drugs is not permitted by participants of an NWT sanctioned championship. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted by any participant under the legal drinking age.

### **Sanctions:**

All competitors who do not comply with obligations of the Competitors/Coaches shall be sanctioned in the following manner:

- As prescribed in the Rules of Officiated Play of the Canadian Curling Association.
- As prescribed in the NWT Curling Association Policy Manual
- Not participating in the next level of Play:
  - If a team which is registered does not attend a NWT or Yukon/NWT championship, all players registered on that team will be suspended from competitive play at the NWT or higher level for one calendar year from the date of the incident.
- Not attending the Team Meeting:
  - If you fail to have at least one member present during the Team Meeting, the offending team will lose hammer and choice of rocks for the duration of the Championship.
- Not attending the Championship Banquet:
  - If a person is not present at the banquet during a NWT Championship, their home club will be billed \$50.00 per missing member. In addition, if the team who the person is a member of represents the NWT at the Y/NWT level, their teams' travel assistance will be reduced by \$500.00.
  - If a person is not present at the banquet during a Yukon/NWT Championship, the individual will be billed \$50.00. In addition, if the team who the person is a member of represents the Yukon/NWT at the National level, their teams' clothing allowance will be reduced by \$500.00.
